Monday, July 2nd was the take-down of our June Faulkner show (all work collected on time) and the ingathering and jurying for our July show. Despite the odd hours, we had 90 entries and the juror, Thomas Van Stein, selected 69 pieces to hang and gave the following awards: 1st Place to **Frances Reighley** for *Couch Potatoes*, Second Place to **Gloria Peyrat** for *Girl in the Red Sweater* and Third Place to **Jim Golden** for *Off Season*. Honorable Mentions went to **Robert Trimble** for *The View Off San Rafael Mountain*, **Britt Friedman** for *Valley From San Marcos Pass*, **Ronald Abeles** for *Santa Barbara Light*, **Rica Coulter** for *Encircled* and **Simone Reddingius** for *Last Night*. Our First Thursday reception was fairly well attended considering that we now only have 2 hours due to the library closing earlier and this time of year many people are still enjoying life outdoors.

The **July show will come down on Monday, July 30 from 1-3 PM.** We are still looking for volunteers to take over planning & managing the Faulkner receptions. We do have a sign-up sheet at ingatherings for volunteers for the evening to set-up and serve but we need "team leaders" to buy all the necessary supplies, drinks and food, and get them to the venue and supervise the reception. We have 2 more receptions at the Faulkner this year in September and December. Larry Mancini (drinks) and I (food and supplies) can work with you for these last 2 receptions to help you get organized and it really only takes a few hours for each event. Please say yes!

The Faulkner is running a very busy schedule this summer and not every event of theirs

gets on the sitting calendar we have at the ingathering so, if you arrive at the Faulkner and find an unexpected event in progress, it is perfectly okay for you to leave.

The entire Board of SBAA is very pleased that so many of you took the time to return your questionnaires with your dues. Frances Reighley has been tabulating the replies and listing, in order of concern, questions and issues that were raised and these will be addressed in the coming months.
