# President's Message by Nancy Hull



The ingathering on December 3 at the Faulkner was both lively and festive, with 152 entries. As of December 5, 3 pieces had already been sold from this show! Our First Thursday reception continued the holiday vibe with the Dixie Daddies playing toe-tapping Dixieland standards and seasonal selections for gallery visitors, many of whom stayed for the duration of the concert. Besides performing at a wide variety of special events, this group donates its time and talents to perform at churches and retirement homes; do check out their website to see where and when you can next enjoy their music.

If in the past you've volunteered to work at either the jurying for new members or for the small galleries selection, you've probably been aware that these events often run late, with a lot of pressure during the last two hours to finalize the results, to provide feedback to participants and to make sure that all the artwork gets retrieved before, ostensibly, 4 PM. At the December board meeting, this issue was discussed, and the members agreed to reduce the window for entries by 30 minutes; the next New Members jurying will be in March, and the entries will close at noon (instead of 12:30), and the jurying will begin at 12:30 (instead of at 1:00). If we were to add more time at the end of the process, it would increase SBAA's cost of renting the facility, so we're hoping to solve the issue of the hectic late afternoon by trimming time off the entry time.

At this time, the SBAA shows at the Faulkner assigned by the library are slated for June, August, and December; as during 2018, should there be a cancellation, it's possible that we'll add another show. Meanwhile, there will be quarterly shows going up at the **Hutton starting January 12 and 1919 State starting February 9** as well as the March ingathering for the International Orchid Show. Additionally, we have been added back to the show calendar at the JCC (Jewish Community Center), with the ingathering slated for late August, and the show ending in October. Please keep an eye on the calendar you see each month in the newsletter, and watch for email blasts, for alerts to new shows or changes to those already scheduled.

I won't see most of you until the December 30 takedown for the Holiday Show, so I'll take this opportunity to thank you for your participation this past year and to wish you a new year filled with artistic adventures and inspiration. Best wishes to you all!

As Vice President in a large international management consulting company, I had a successful but stressful career developing large mainframe computer systems in the USA and Europe. I retired early in 1998 to Santa Barbara where I had graduated from UCSB in 1968.

I realized immediately that my paintings had a linear style rather than the painterly style of the artists I admired. I concluded that my analytical approach and obsessive compulsive behavior were not going to change, so, I decided to select subject matter to fit my natural inclinations.

I have painted landscapes, buildings, and portraits but find the greatest joy in painting flowers. I am fascinated by the infinite variety and the intricate structure of each flower. My goal is not to paint a botanically perfect flower but to capture the flowing movement inherent in each bloom.
