Vice President Nancy Hull's Message

On **Saturday, October 22**, SBAA will jury applicants for membership in the Santa Barbara Art Association.

Do you have artist friends who might be interested in joining SBAA? If so, please pass along the following information, as missing this opportunity will mean waiting until the Spring of 2023. There's nothing to fill out ahead of time and, if you remember, the process couldn't be easier.

- 1) Deliver 3 gallery-ready original works of art – all in the same medium – to the Faulkner Gallery between 10:30 and 12:30;
- 2) pay the \$25 jurying fee in cash or by check, and fill out a short entry form;
- 3) find something to do while the jurors complete reviewing all the submitted art;
- 4) return at 3:00 to find out if you have been accepted and retrieve your art. If accepted, the new members will also need to pay the membership fee in cash or by check.

For more details, go to www.SBartassoc.org and under the **INFORMATION** tab, select **How to Join** from the drop-down menu.

As you can see from the calendar page, the next few months will offer a number of show opportunities for SBAA members, so now is the time to plan how to distribute your work AND complete some new pieces.

After a 3-month hiatus, SBAA will again have a members' only juried show in the main Faulkner Gallery for the **month of November; ingathering is on Tuesday, November 1**. You may enter up to 3 pieces at \$10 each with no size limit. *The takedown for this show will occur at the same time as the ingathering for our December show.*

Our SBAA members' only juried quarterly show at 1919 State Street will **change Saturday, November 12**. This show remains up for three months.

Lastly, keep in mind for planning purposes that our **December Non-Juried show** is in the main gallery and both side galleries so we can accept everything you care to enter as long as it is fit for public viewing.

This show's **ingathering is Tuesday, November 29** and has a price limit of \$500 per item or you can enter something to display that is not for sale (NFS). You may enter up to 3 pieces at \$10 each and there is no size limit. This is when our members bring affordable art to the community. The take down for the December show at the Faulkner will be on **Tuesday, December 23** as the library closes over Christmas.

You can always ask a friend to drop off your pieces for a show as long as the friend has the necessary information for the entry form and fee or ask a friend to pick up your pieces if you email me at nancyhull963@gmail.com to let me know to whom I can release the pieces.
